Whatever your requirements, we will work with you to ensure your needs and expectations are met.


Welcome...

The Grove is a converted hotel-style property that provides short breaks to adults with learning and physical disabilities from 18 to 65. Offering 24 hour support, The Grove is ideal for those looking for a relaxing break or in need of respite, whilst offering a variety of social and recreational activities and entertainment. Situated in it's own private grounds in the centre of Old Birtley The Grove is easily acessible and close to all main transport links and amenities in Gateshead, Newcastle and Durham. The main house has eight ensuite bedrooms, two lounges and a kitchen area.

Three of the bedrooms are downstairs, two of which are equipped with ceiling tracking to allow ease of movement for those who require support. The Grove's main bathroom also offers tracking over a modified spa bath and an adapted shower to accommodate a cradle or chair. Guests who come to The Grove have a range of needs and can make use of the facilities that are available and can relax and enjoy an environment that most suits them.

There are two lounges and both offer an opportunity to enjoy the facilities available such as a large screen TV, stereo, DVD player, PC and games/Wii console. All meals and drinks cater for individuals needs and preferences.


